Virtual Work Experience Week

Monday 18 July - Thursday 21 July

As per the college calendar, all our Year 9 and 10 learners will be taking part in Virtual Work Experience during the last week of term.

We have secured this opportunity with Bouygues (<u>Home - Bouygues UK (bouygues-uk.com)</u> who we have worked closely with in terms of apprenticeships with our KS5 learners.

Day 1

- 10.00am Learners attend a **Teams** meeting hosted by Bouygues which includes:
 - o Introduction to the virtual work experience platform and the week
 - o 30 minute video
 - 10 minute Go Construct quiz learning about roles within the industry
 - Reconvene to discuss roles and launch the task
 LDE UTC Staff members will also be present at this
- 11.00am Learners access the platform to begin their task
- 12.30pm Learners attend a **Teams** meeting hosted by Bouygues for de-brief and introduction to day 2.

Day 2/3

- 10.00am Learners attend a **Teams** meeting with Bouygues
- 10.30am Launch task learners work independently from a link available on Teams
 - o World of work, videos, interaction and other activities
 - Tuesday Sustainability
 - Wednesday Design
- 12.30pm Learners attend a Teams meeting to debrief
 - End of day 3



Day 4

- 10.00am Celebration on Teams
 - o 30 minute presentation from Project Manager
- 10.30am **Teams** Breakout rooms for presentations. Number of rooms will depend on numbers as discussed end of day 3.
- 11.00am 11.30am All together for Prizes on Teams

LDE staff will be logging in as well throughout the day and each teacher has been allocated a group of learners to support throughout the process, including making contact each day by telephone. Please note that these phone calls may come up as a private number. Learners are expected to attend each day and registers will be taken, with unauthorised absences logged.

Whilst in the **Teams** meetings, learners

- Will all be muted
- Can have their cameras off
- Need to raise their virtual hand to ask questions
- Note that the chatroom facility will be disabled
