Appeal of Results – Summer 2023

If having received your results you feel that you have a clear reason to appeal the outcome the college can challenge a grade on your behalf by requesting the exam board review the exam entry.

There are several options available to you – see below:

- Clerical Review - this will ensure all pages of exam papers are marked, all marks are counted and that the results match the marks on the papers. THIS WILL NOT MEAN THE PAPERS ARE REMARKED.
- Review of Marking - this will include the clerical check above and will have a second examiner review the paper to identify marking errors or unreasonable marking.
- 3. Priority Review (GCE and L3 Only) - as review of marking above but completed in a shorter time frame. This has a deadline of 22 August 2023

You should be aware that any appeal against results will have:

- The potential for your grade to go up or down.
- A fee attached, this could range from £8.70 to £70.75 depending on the level of qualification and the type of review requested – see below.
