Your resilience and determination despite the pandemic have allowed you to achieve your best which is demonstrated by the outstanding results your year group have achieved, these include:

Average Technical result was a Distinction +

- Built Environment Advanced Technical Certificate learners achieved an average grade of Distinction +
- Engineering Diploma learners achieved an average grade of Distinction Distinction
- Digital Media Diploma learners achieved an average grade of Distinction Distinction
- Digital Media Extended Certificate learners achieved an average grade of Distinction*

Average A Level result was a B

Progress

- On average our A Level Learners achieved 0.5 grades higher than their predictions based off of their GCSE Grades
- On average our Technical Learners achieved 1.6 grades higher than their predictions based off of their GCSE Grades

Attainment

- 24% of learners achieved an average grade of A/Distinction or higher
- 27% of learners achieved at least 3 grade B's or higher at Level 3
- 80% of learners achieved at least one grade B or higher at Level 3
