TURNITIN ASSESSMENT & DEADLINES

Recently we consulted with our apprentices and as a result of feedback on our deadline and hand in protocol we have implemented a solution called Turnitin which ensures Deadlines set by tutors are final and provides a complete solution for submitting work to your tutors.

As of January 2020 we will be making use of further elements of Turnitin such as the feedback studio, we will be releasing information on this in the coming weeks and will be running an information session.



E-LEARNING

We will again be running our e-learning module over the festive break, which provides you with the flexibility of working on your Knowledge, Skills and Behaviours virtually during periods of College closure.
