Wow! This has been an incredibly demanding term for our learners, their parents/carers and our staff, however our college community has shown strength, resilience and a desire to progress well despite what the pandemic has thrown at us.

Our attendance both during lockdown and back on site has been remarkable. In fact, we are averaging just under 95% which is way above the national 93%, and local 92% averages. When we surveyed our learners to find out their thoughts, they said that they are enjoying their education and feel safe with the measures put into place to make the college as safe as possible during the pandemic.

We have set up reminder texts with direct clickable links so that you don't forget. It is important that we all take the tests and report the positive or negative result. Your participation in reporting your results means that we can act quickly as a college by isolating close contacts, thus protecting all of our community and their families.

Many of you will be aware, particularly those of you who are taking your exams this year, that the DfE, Ofqual and JCQ have created a new system for awarding the grades called Teacher Assessed Grades (TAGS) for this academic year. This is different to last year's system and the system in previous years, due to the pandemic. I will be writing separately to those directly concerned but wanted to inform and signpost the wider college community to where you can find LDE UTC's information.
