As you know, the team at WHU Foundation spoke to the learners a couple of weeks ago. Overview of NCS Programme:

3 phases over the two weeks of programme.

Week 1: Residential – based at an outward-bounds activity centre. 2 days with high adventure and 3 days that focus on developing new skills.

Week 2: Local Community Hub - Do Good- planning and delivering a Social Action Project over the course of 5 days.

Programme Dates:

Wave 1	11 th – 15 th July and 18 th – 22 nd July.
Wave 2	25 th – 29 th July and 1 st – 5 th August.
Wave 3	15 th – 19 th August and 22 nd – 26 th August.
